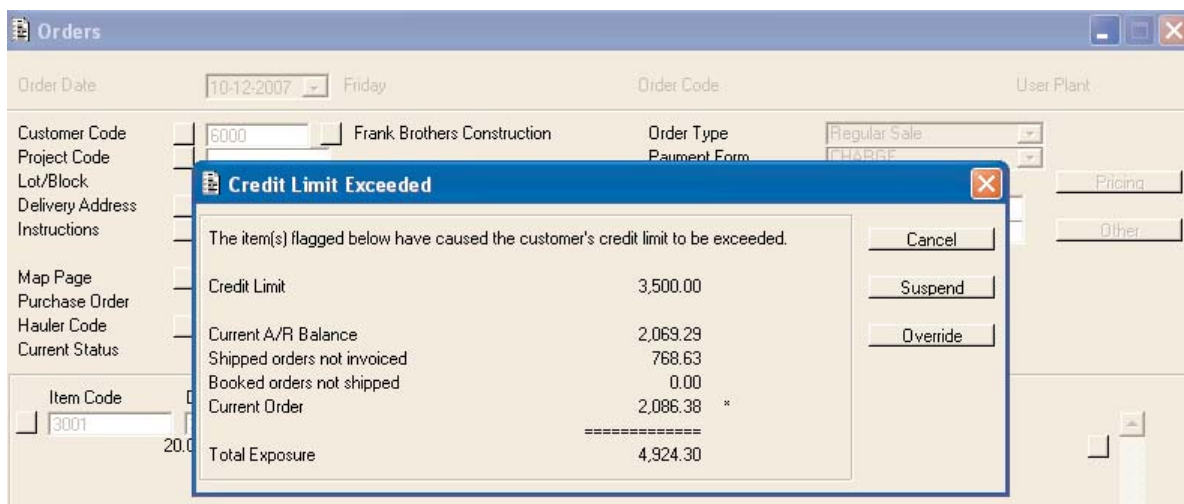


COMMANDcredit automatically checks the credit limit of a customer in real-time once an order is created or edited.

When a customer's credit limit is exceeded by an order during the order entry process, a warning window with detailed credit information is displayed. The credit limit is also checked again during ticketing for the first ticket of the day on any given order. If desired, password authorization can allow the dispatcher to proceed with the shipment of an order that has exceeded a customer's credit limit. A *Credit Limit Report* is made available with AR balance, total exposure, shipped orders not invoiced, and booked orders not shipped.

"COMMANDcredit gives us instant access to customer payment history and lets our dispatchers know immediately when an account has been placed on Credit Hold.
